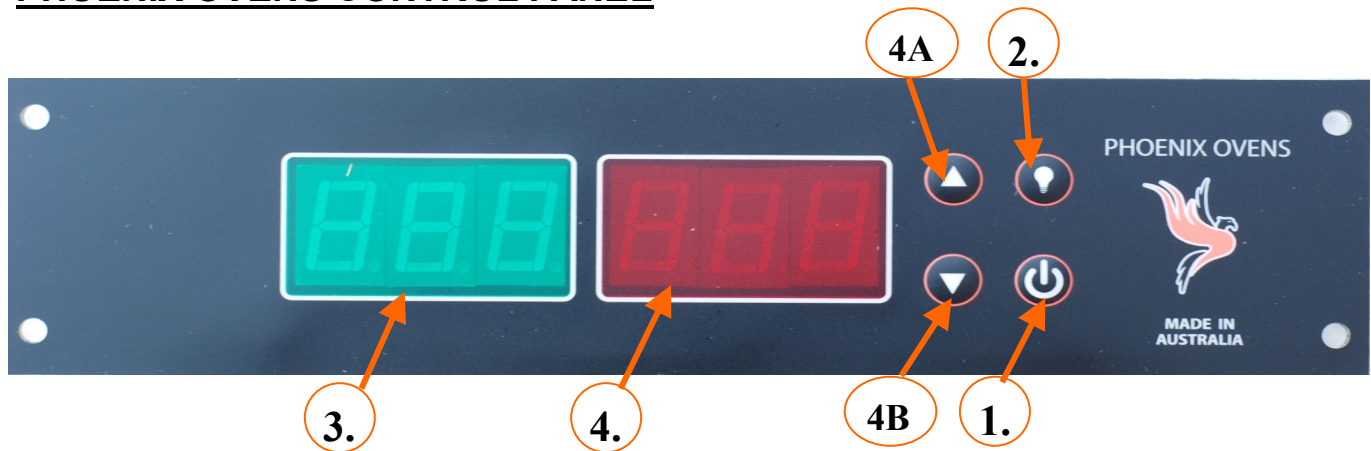


# GAS CONTROL SYSTEM & FUNCTIONS

## PHOENIX OVENS CONTROL PANEL



- 1. CONTROL BUTTON (ON/OFF) & FLAME FAILURE RESET OPERATION**
- 2. OVEN INTERNAL LIGHT (ON/OFF)**
- 3. “PV” Present Value OVEN TEMPERATURE (BURNER FAILURE INDICATION CODE.)**
- 4. “SV” Set Value OVEN TEMPERATURE (BURNER FAILURE INDICATION CODE.)**
  - 4A. ADJUST OVEN TEMPERATURE HIGHER BY PRESSING**
  - 4B. ADJUST OVEN TEMPERATURE LOWER BY PRESSING**

IN CASE OF NO POWER (NO LIGHTS) ON THE CONTROL PANEL, THE GAS SYSTEM IS INTERLOCKED TO THE OPERATION AND TEMPERATURE OF THE EXHAUST SYSTEM. (AS1556) CHECK:

1. THE EXHAUST FAN IS OPERATING (main switch in rear of kitchen).
2. CHECK THE EXHAUST FILTER. Blockage of the filter will cause exhaust to overheat. SEE PG 19. FOR FILTER INSTRUCTION.

The system will need to be manually restarted/reset by pushing control button (1) when power is restored.
